- ABOUT THE TERMINAL**
- Largest export terminal on the U.S. Gulf Coast, capable of handling Handymax, Panamax, and Capesize vessels
  - Only terminal on the lower Mississippi with direct rail access
  - Two rail loops hold 300 railcars on-site, and allow unloading of unit trains without breaking; two 8500' long ladder tracks supplement the rail loops
  - Installed rotary dump capabilities, enhancing flexibility to handle various products
  - Radial stacker with iron ore yard
  - Provides strategic access to seaborne markets for coal, iron ore, petcoke, liquids, and other industrial materials
  - Dual berths capable of handling Capesize and Panamax vessels simultaneously
  - Loading rate of 30,000 tons per day, with potential for 40,000 tons per day
  - Receives inbound commodities via rail or barge, and ships outbound commodities via vessel

**ABOUT THE COMPANY** SunCoke is the largest independent U.S. producer of coke, currently supplying approximately 3.7 million tons to domestic and international steelmakers. We have U.S. cokemaking facilities in Virginia, Indiana, Ohio and Illinois, and international operations in Vitória, Brazil. Our industrial services business provides export and domestic material handling services to coke, coal, steel, power and other bulk customers, as well as mission-critical services to leading steel producers globally. The logistics terminals process raw materials and act as intermediaries between our customers and end users for both the U.S. and global export markets. Additional industrial services include the removal, handling, and processing of molten slag at customer sites, as well as preparation and transportation of metal scraps, raw materials, and finished products.

**LOGISTICS TERMINALS** Our logistics terminals have the collective capacity to blend and transload more than 40 million tons of coal each year and are strategically located to reach Gulf Coast, East Coast, Great Lakes, and international ports. We are a leading provider of coal handling services in the Ohio River Valley Basin and Gulf Coast region with more than 30 years of experience receiving, blending, storing, and transloading thermal and metallurgical coals.

**OTHER SUNCOKE LOGISTICS TERMINALS** Our fleet of terminals are located on Lake Michigan and the Mississippi, Ohio, and Kanawha Rivers, and designed for high-throughput offloading and storage of coal and other products from river barges, ocean vessels, trucks, and railcars.
